RAPPERSWIL

- Rose Garden The garden has a whopping 16,000 rose bushes which form a colourful
 carpet in between the vine yards and the lake. A sight to behold these gardens form
 for a true compelling experience.
- Rapperswil Castle is the landmark of the picturesque "City of Roses", which lies on the shores of Lake Zurich

ST.GALLEN

- **Old Town** The best thing to do in St. Gallen is take a tour of St. Gallen's Old Town. The district has a Baroque cathedral and one of the world's oldest libraries.
- The Abbey of Saint Gall is a dissolved abbey in a Catholic religious complex in the city of St. Gallen in Switzerland.
- **St. Gallen Cathedral** The Stiftskirche St. Gallus und Otmar is a Roman Catholic church in the city of St. Gallen, Switzerland. Part of the Abbey of St. Gall, it has been the cathedral of the Diocese of St. Gallen since 1847.

CHUR

(B/D)

- **Old Town** With a settlement history of over 5000 years, Chur is the oldest city in Switzerland and is considered one of the most fully preserved in the country.
- St. Martin's Church was originally a Romanesque church built in the 8th century and consecrated in 769 AD.

ZERMATT

- Zermatt Town, at an elevation of around 1,600m, lies below the iconic, pyramidshaped Matterhorn peak. Its main street, Bahnhofstrasse is lined with boutique shops, hotels and restaurants.
- Matterhorn is a mountain of the Alps, straddling the main watershed and border between Switzerland and Italy. It is a large, near-symmetric pyramidal peak in the extended Monte Rosa area of the Pennine Alps.

INTERLAKEN

 Interlaken Town - in the mountainous Bernese Oberland region of central Switzerland. Built on a narrow stretch of valley, between the emerald-colored waters of Lake Thun and Lake Brienz, it has old timber houses and parkland on either side of the Aare River.

SWISS ALPS

- The Top of Europe is a high-altitude building located in the Swiss canton of Valais. It overlooks the eternal snows of the Aletsch Glacier from the south side of the Jungfraujoch, at a height of 3,454 metres above sea level.
- Mt.Titlis is a mountain in Central Switzerland, to be reached by a revolving cable car. At 3032 m, you can enjoy the eternal snow and the beautiful views.

LUCERNE

- Lion Monument is a sculpture in Lucerne, Switzerland, It commemorates the Swiss Guards who were massacred in 1792 during the French Revolution, when revolutionaries stormed the Tuileries Palace in Paris, France.
- Wooden Chapel Bridge is a covered wooden footbridge spanning diagonally across the Reuss River in the city of Lucerne in central Switzerland.
