#### **NIKKO**

- **Ashikaga Flower Park** you can see 350 blooming wisteria flowers, flowing downward from above, creating a world of enchantment.
- **Hitachi Seaside Park** offers visitors the chance to enjoy spectacular displays of seasonal flowers year-round.
- **Toshugu Shrine** it forms the Shrines and Temples of Nikkō UNESCO World Heritage Site, with 42 structures of the shrine included in the nomination.
- Irohazaka Zigzag Driveway -up the mountain where we will stop over to visit the stunning **Kegon Falls** and overview the beautiful scenery.
- **Kegon Falls** The almost 100 meter tall Kegon Waterfall is the most famous of Nikko's many beautiful waterfalls.

#### **GUNMA**

- **Gunma Fruit Farm** · The most satisfying way to eat fruit is by picking it straight from the tree yourself.
- **Shiraito Falls** Ranked among the most beautiful waterfalls in Japan, the 150 meter wide cascade is fed by the volcano's spring water and flows off the edge of a 20 meter high cliff in thin white streams that resemble hanging threads of silk hence its name.

#### **TATEYAMA ALPINE**

- **Snow Corridor** is a 500-metre-long path along the Tateyama Kurobe Alpine Route close to the Murodo Plateau. The trail is lined by towering snow walls up to 20 metres tall.
- We traverse the route using a variety of vehicles (6 types) with an elevation change 2400 meters. Vehicles includes **Tateyama Cable Car**, **Tateyama Highland Bus**, **Tateyama Tunnel Trolley Bus**, **Tateyama Ropeway**, **Kurobe Cable Car** and **Kanden Tunnel Electric Bus**.
- Kurobe Dam Completed in 1963 after 7 years of labour by 10 million workers, this is Japan's largest arch-style dam.

#### **TAKAYAMA**

- **Shirakawa Go** a small, traditional village showcasing a building style known as gasshō-zukuri. It is one of UNESCO's World Heritage Sites.
- **Shirakawago Observation Deck** you can overlook the whole village of Shirakawa-go, Ogi-cho, the gassho-style village, and the peaks.
- **Hida Great Limestone Cave** discovered in 1965, this is the only cave with "herictites" in Japan. The herictites curve both to the left and the right inside the cave.
- **Takayama's Old Town** has been beautifully preserved with many buildings and whole streets of houses dating from the Edo Period (1603-1868),
- Takayama Miyagawa Morning Market of fresh locally grown fruits, vegetable, flowers and more, you will enjoy shopping and interacting with the locals in Japan!
