DAY 1 SINGAPORE ✈️ BEIJING

HOTEL (LOCAL 4★)

Arrive at Beijing International Airport, then transfer to the hotel after being picked up.

DAY 2 BEIJING

HOTEL (LOCAL 4★) B / L / D

The famous tourist attractions in downtown Beijing include **Tiananmen Square**, which is a political and historical center with the Monument to the People's Heroes. **The Great Hall of the People** and the National Museum exhibit modern architectural styles representing China's modernization. **The Forbidden City** symbolizes ancient Chinese imperial culture. **Wangfujing Street** is renowned for its historical and cultural significance as a commercial hub. **Pingguoju**, an old **Beijing brand**, recreates scenes from the 1980s, providing a nostalgic experience and serving as a popular spot for social media check-ins.

DAY 3 BEIJING

HOTEL (LOCAL 4★) B / L

Shougang Park is a very interesting tourist destination, especially for those who enjoy skiing. There is a Winter Olympic ski jump here, which is one of the best places for taking photos. **The Summer Palace** and **Yuanmingyuan** are famous imperial gardens with a long history and beautiful scenery. Here, you can experience the lifestyle of ancient Chinese emperors and nobles and admire many beautiful buildings and landscapes. **The Bird's Nest** and **Water Cube** are two of the most famous modern architectural landmarks, having been the main venues for the 2008 Beijing Olympics. Even if you're not a sports enthusiast, you will be attracted by their appearances.

DAY 4 BEIJING - GUBEI WATER TOWN

HOTEL (LOCAL 4★) B / L / D

Simatai Xiaoshao Liquor Distillery is a long-standing distillery known for producing traditional Chinese liquor. **Yongshun Dye House** is a traditional dye factory where visitors can learn about the production process of traditional Chinese dyes. **Yang Wudi Temple** is a temple dedicated to General Yang Wudi. **The Eight Banners Guild Hall** was a gathering place for descendants of the Eight Banners during the Qing Dynasty and has now become a venue showcasing the history and culture of the Qing Dynasty. After visiting these attractions, you can take a leisurely stroll on the **Simatai Great Wall** (excluding cable car) and enjoy the magnificent scenery of the Great Wall. The water town at night also has its own unique charm. During the **Great Wall Water Dance Light Show**, you can enjoy dazzling lights and colorful dance performances, leaving you captivated. Additionally, you can witness drone sky lanterns at the water town, a creative and beautiful light show that offers a unique experience.

DAY 5 GUBEI WATER TOWN - CHENGDE

HOTEL (LOCAL 4★) B / L / D

A must-visit when traveling to **Chengde City**, China. This mountain features two ancient pagodas built over 1300 years ago by the Khitan people. These pagodas remain a mystery, leaving people wondering how ancient builders constructed such remarkable structures. Additionally, within **Shuangta Mountain** is the Puning Temple, home to the world's largest gilded wooden statue of the Thousand-Armed Avalokiteshvara Bodhisattva. The unique-shaped Qinchui Peak is another highlight of Shuangta Mountain, resembling a giant hammer. At night, **Kangxi Street Night Market** is a must-visit destination where you can indulge in various cuisines and experience local culture and customs. Whether you're a culture enthusiast or a foodie, Shuangta Mountain and Chengde City will leave you with unforgettable memories.

DAY 6

CHENGDE - TIANJIN

The Eastern Qing Tombs in Hebei Province, China, are a grand imperial mausoleum complex for Emperor Guangxu, Empress Dowager Cixi, and the Qing dynasty. The site includes sacrificial squares, tombs, and a palace. Popular attractions are the tombs of **Empress Dowager Cixi and Emperor Qianlong**. Visitors can also explore Tianjin after visiting the tombs.

DAY 7

TIANJIN - BEIJING

HOTEL (LOCAL 5★)

On the food street, enjoy **Tianjin cuisine**. Explore **Ancient Culture Street** for traditional vibes. Visit **Five Great Avenues** for European-style architecture and cultural charm. Experience **Tianjin Eye Ferris wheel** and **Hai River** boat tour for city views. See the unique **Porcelain House** and **Italian Style Street** for a taste of Italy.
