DAY 3
PALERMO-CEFALU-AGRIGENTO

(B/D)

Visit the **Norman Palace**, a symbol of the historical and cultural heritage of Sicily. It played a central role in the region's history, serving as the seat of power for various rulers and empires. **Palatine Chapel** is a masterpiece of medieval art and architecture located within the Norman Palace (Palazzo dei Normanni) in Palermo, Sicily Italy.

Afterwards, visit the beautiful **Coastal Town** of Cefalu, a historical center characterized by its medieval architecture and charming narrow streets.

The **Valley of the Temples** is one of the most outstanding examples of ancient Greek architecture; designated as a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

DAY 4
AGRIGENTO - TAORMINA

Continue your journey in **Agrigento Old Town**. Visit the **Cathedral of San Gerlando**, a Norman Cathedral with a mix of architectural styles. Stroll through narrow medieval streets and discover local shops.

Afterwards, enjoy the **Ancient Theatre** in Taormina, one of the town's most iconic landmarks. Dating back to the 3rd century BCE, the theater is well-preserved and offers panoramic views of the sea and Mount Etna.

Afterwards, explore the **Island of Ortygia**, a captivating blend of history, culture and natural beauty. Its compact size makes it easy to explore on foot, and its rich heritage provides a unique experience for those visitng Syracuse.

Transfer to the port and board a ferry 🚢 to Valletta, Malta.

St. John's Co-Cathedral is a Baroque-style co-cathedral located in Valletta, the capital city of Malta. It is one of the most notable historical and religious landmarks in Malta.

The Grand Master's Palace was originally built as a residence for the Grand Master of the Order of St. John in the 16th century, Grand Master Jean de la Cassière.
